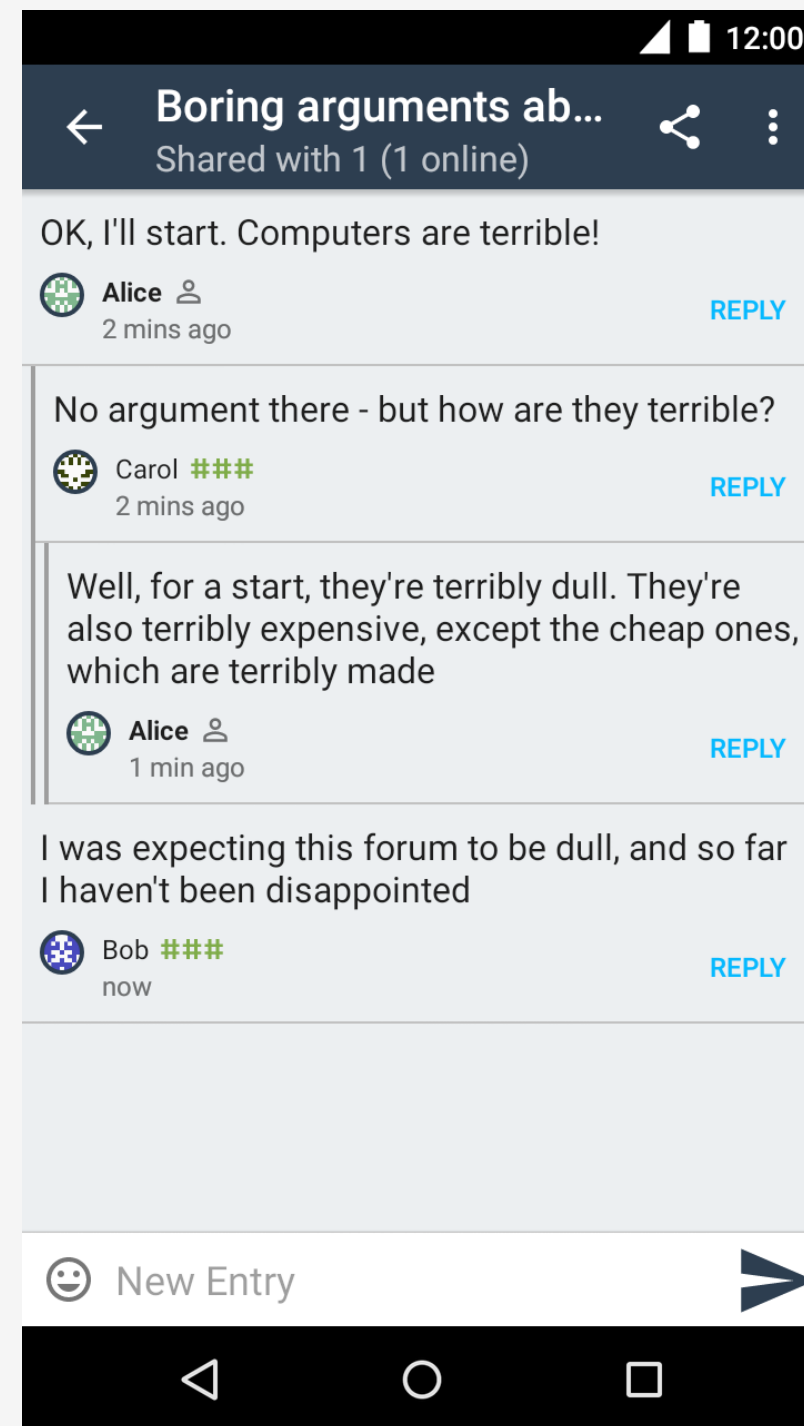
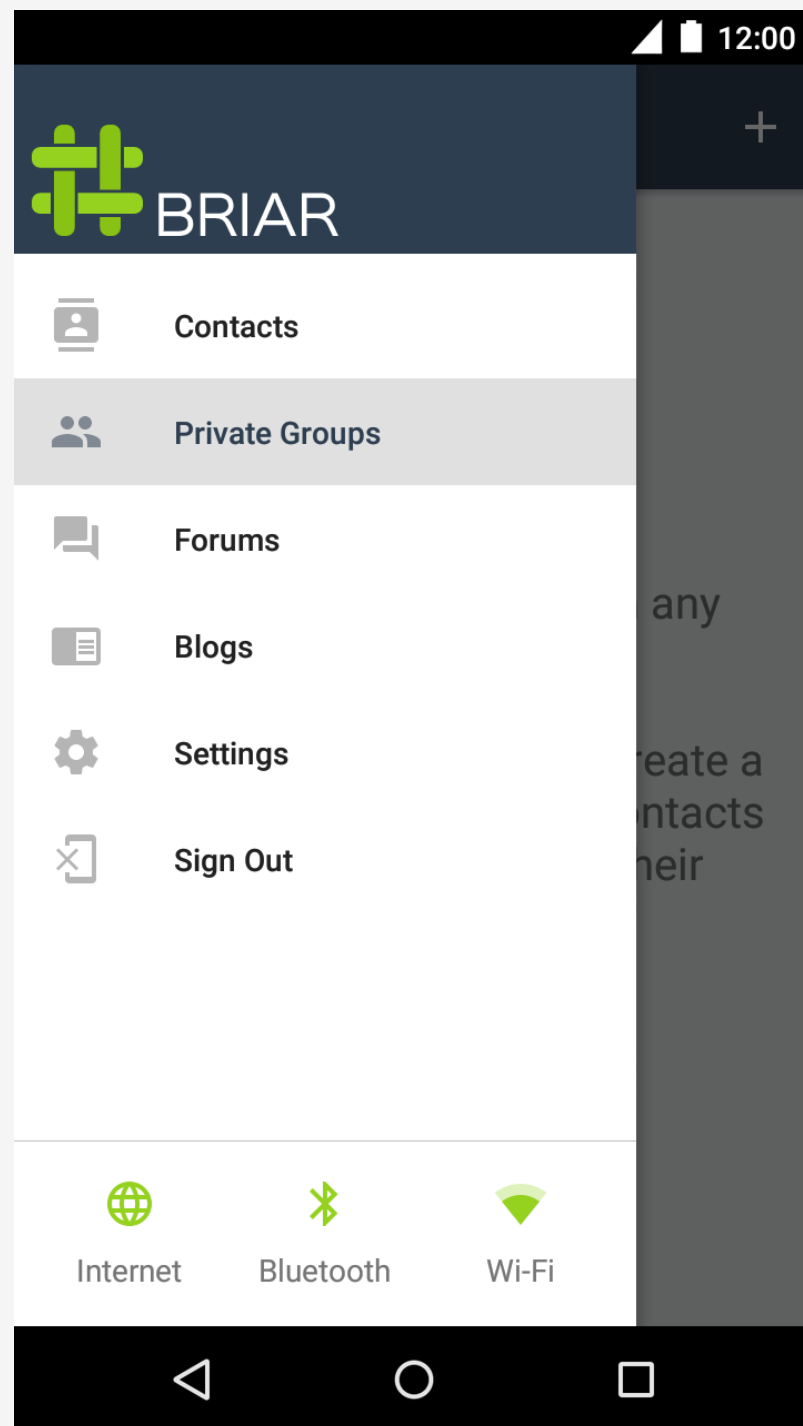
Mensageria

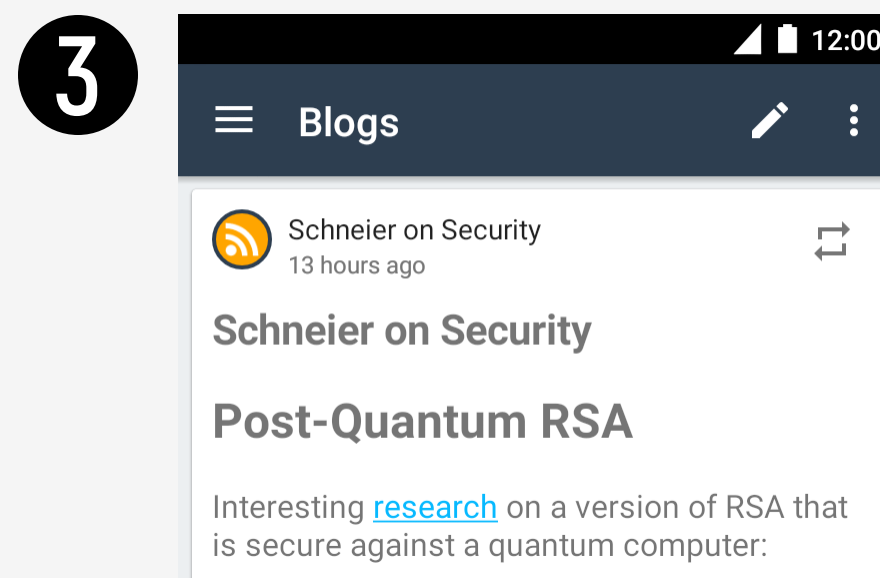
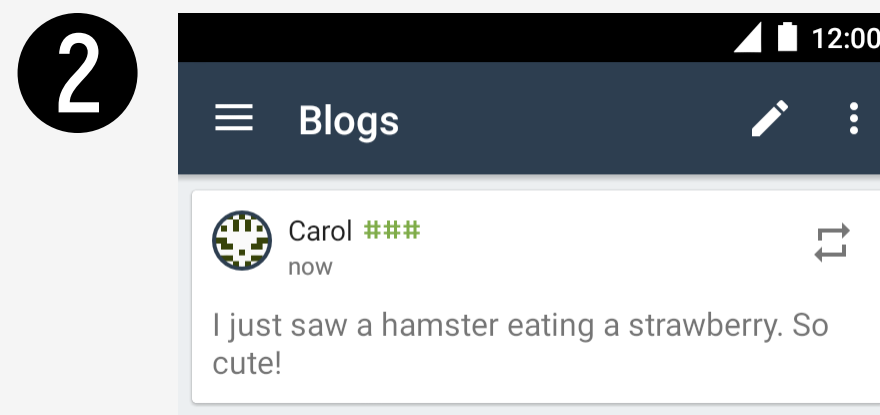
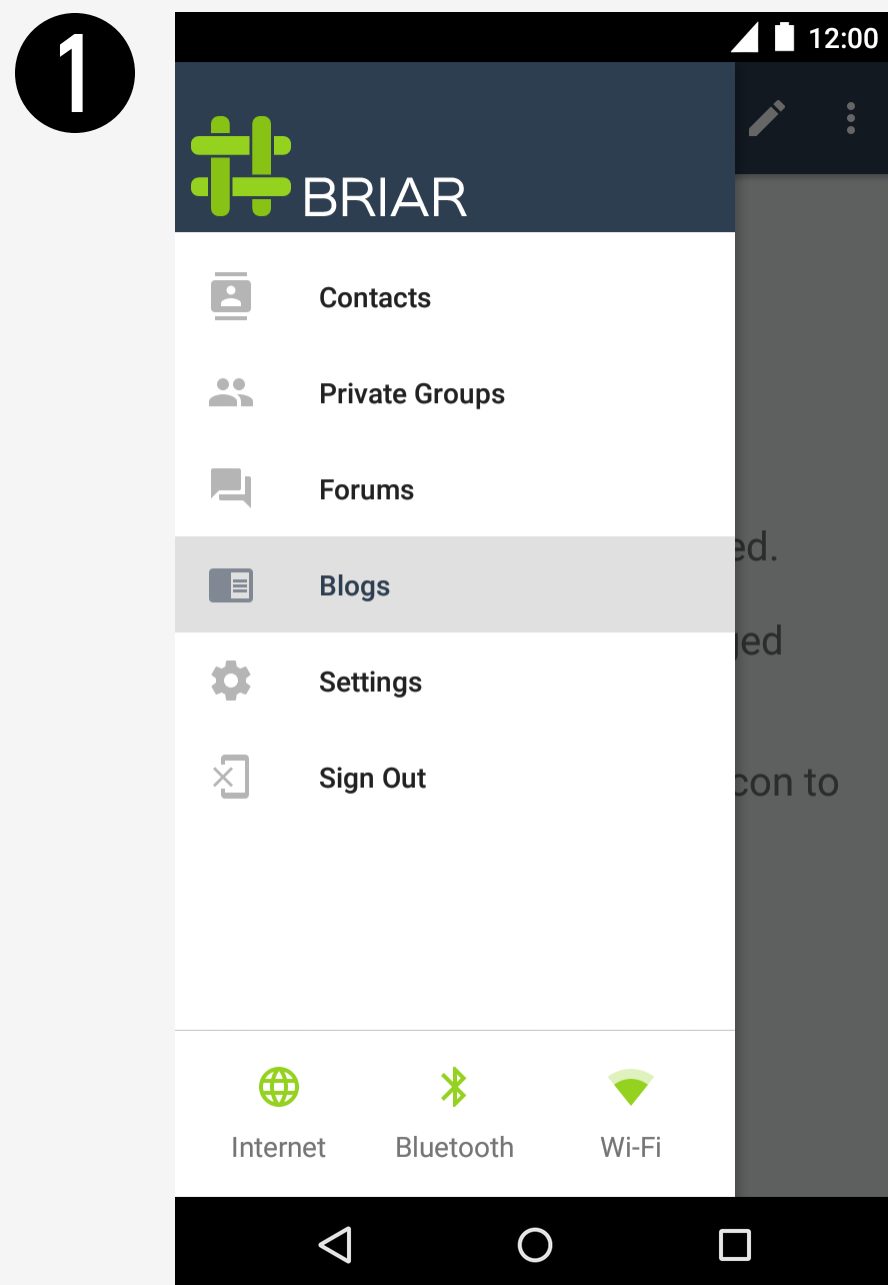
